Instructions For Use, 32 oz. Trigger Spray:

Surface area should be clean and free of Mold before applying this product. If Mold is present, use Moldex Disinfectant to stop the growth.

KITCHEN & HOUSEHOLD SURFACES: Spray on surface, rub with stiff bristled brush if necessary. Rinse with clean water. Wipe dry.

TILE AND GROUT: Spray on surface. Allow a few minutes dwell time. Rub with stiff bristled brush. Rinse with clean water. Reapply if needed.

CARPET & FABRIC: Always test for color fastness before using any chemical on fabrics. Remove loose soil from surface. Spray area and allow to penetrate for 3-5 minutes. Blot with white cloth. Rinse cloth and repeat until clean. Do not use on leather or silk.

Instructions For Use, Outdoor Hose-End Attachment:

1. Shake well before using.
2. Connect Sprayer to Hose.
3. Turn on water.
4. To begin spraying, point nozzle in the direction you want to spray.
5. Bend small plastic tab back and turn knob clockwise to ON position.
6. Spray surface liberally and evenly.
7. Rub with stiff bristled brush if necessary.

8. To stop spraying, turn knob counter-clockwise to OFF position.
9. Turn water off.
10. Relieve water pressure by turning knob to ON position until water slows to a drip.
Then, turn
knob back to OFF position.
11. Disconnect sprayer from hose.
